

## Electrical Permit Fees

### RESIDENTIAL (ONE AND TWO FAMILY PROPERTIES)

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Minimum Permit Fee - \$25

Additional

- o \$25 for each \$1,000 or fraction thereof of estimated electrical construction costs

Maximum Permit Fee - \$7,500

State Surcharge - \$4

City Surcharge - \$3

Note

- o All Electrical Permits for 1 and 2 family properties are "EZ Permits" (see "EZ Permits" below)
- o No plans are required for 1 and 2 family properties
- o Although "rough-in" inspections are required there is no rough-in fee for 1 and 2 family properties

### COMMERCIAL

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Fees in this section apply to the following types of properties:

- o Commercial
- o Mixed Use (Commercial and Residential)
- o Residential Properties with more than 2 units

Minimum Permit Fee - \$25

Filing Fee (if plan review is required) - \$100

Additional

- o \$25 for each \$1,000 or fraction thereof of estimated electrical construction costs

Maximum Permit Fee - \$7,500

Accelerated Plan Review - \$540 (in addition to regular permit fees)

State Surcharge - \$4

Imaging Surcharge - \$4 per page of plans \*

City Surcharge - \$3

Rough-in Fee - \$125 (optional)

A Rough-in Permit allows work to start under certain conditions and regulations

**EZ Permits** – In the very near future, the Department expects to have Electrical Permits for construction that would not require submittal of plans available through our website. As with our On-line Fast Form Building Permits, these "EZ Electrical" Permits will be processed via a credit card. Licensed Electrical Contractors interested in setting up an On-line Account for these permits can do so by going to the On-line Fast Form Building Permits section of our website and following the directions.

\* - an imaging fee (\$4 per page) of plans associated with permit applications is in effect. This fee pertains to each page in a set of plans that are part of the approved permit(s). Imaging fees are collected at the time the permit is issued.
