

InStore Program

A forgivable loan program that helps eligible retail, food, and creative businesses grow.

The InStore Program helps eligible businesses and organizations purchase equipment and materials associated with establishing a new location or expanding an existing one.

You may be eligible if you own a property occupied by a retail, food, or creative business and are planning to open a new location, make improvements to an existing location in order to expand services or business activities.

The forgivable loan amount is \$15,000-\$50,000 for a project. The forgivable loan does not require payments and is forgiven if the recipient meets program guidelines for five years.

The project must be located on an eligible corridor. A list of eligible corridors is available on the InStore Program application, found at www.phila.gov/business

Eligible Improvements Include:

- kitchen equipment
- coolers, refrigeration units
- computer ordering systems
- display furnishings & shelving
- point of sale equipment
- security systems
- telephone systems
- alarm systems
- millwork
- flooring
- lighting
- sound systems
- theater seating
- HVAC equipment
- specialty piping



Project Evaluation Criteria

Projects will be evaluated based on a variety of criteria, including the following priorities:

- 1. Generation of increased foot traffic to the commercial corridor
- 2. Financial feasibility of the project
- 3. Equity investment from the applicant
- 4. Impact on job retention or creation
- 5. Demonstration of community support
- 6. The project would not occur without the support of the InStore Program
- Commerce gives preference to projects located on corridors which have not previously received an InStore Loan and have seen limited amounts of recent private investment and business openings or expansions

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
